



# **ITALIAN CIVIL COURTS**



Two different orientations in the assessment of non economic damages



Omnicomprehensive damage: the damages liquidated on the basis of the tables adopted by each Court are comprehensive of all the non economic damages suffered by the injured party, being it not possible to "duplicate" the request of compensation by making reference to the other categories of damages as, for instance, "moral damages" and "existential damages"



Separate damages: each category of damage is independent from the others and can be compensated separately, irrespective of the existence or ascertainment of the other categories of damage
